

Webcam Information

WHAT TO PURCHASE

You need an external webcam that is compatible with your device. Before purchasing a webcam, identify the type of port on your computer or tablet.

- Most Windows laptops and desktop computers use a **USB-A** port (traditional rectangular USB connection).
- Many newer Mac computers and iPads use a **USB-C** port (small oval-shaped connection).
- Some older iPads use an **8-pin Lightning** connection.

The images below will help you identify your port type and determine which webcam to purchase.

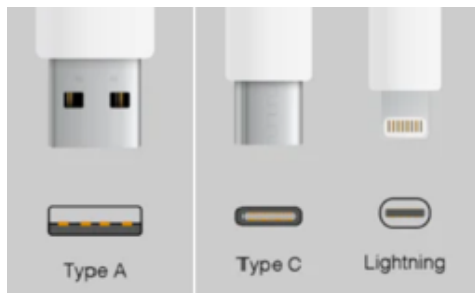
If your device only has USB-C or Lightning ports, you will need one of the following:

- A webcam with a USB-C connection, or
- A USB-A webcam and a USB-A to USB-C adapter, or
- A USB-A webcam and a USB-A to Lightning adapter

WHERE TO PURCHASE

The UAHT Bookstore has a limited number of webcams available for purchase, and the cost may be applied to Pell funds. Webcams are also available from retailers such as Walmart, Target, Amazon, and Best Buy.

A basic webcam typically costs \$20–\$30. To find compatible options, search online for “**external webcam**” plus your port type (USB-A, USB-C, or Lightning).
