**\*Students who do not take PLSC 23003 Texas Government will be required to take Federal and Texas Constitutions and Federal and Texas Political Behavior prior to being accepted into their junior year at TAMUT.**

- **Must be accepted to Texas A&M University-Texarkana as a student before applying to the nursing program. All required university admission documentation must be submitted to the university’s Admissions department in order for them to make an admissions decision. Required documentation must be submitted to their office prior to applying to the nursing program.**
- **Cumulative GPA of 2.8. GPA at time of application is used for admission decisions.**
- **Grade of C or higher (with maximum of two attempts per course) required for courses considered for entry to the program. Applicants with more than two attempts will not be considered for admission.**
- **Pathophysiology & Professional Concepts must be taken at TAMUT be sure to plan accordingly.**
