Program Requirements

- Students not meeting the ACT or equivalent requirements in math and English must enroll in sequential academic skills math, reading, and/or English courses during their first or second semester in college and each subsequent semester until the requirements are successfully completed. Any degree-seeking student who is required to take an academic skills course must also take UNIV 10003 College Life Skills.
- No course substitutions allowed.
- Only courses with a grade of C or better are guaranteed to transfer.
- All UAMS BSN applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale with a grade of C or better in all College of Nursing general education prerequisite courses AND a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale, including those with a previous baccalaureate or higher degree, on all completed college/university coursework.
