Paramedic Overview

This is a one-year program that that will prepare students for the Paramedic Licensure Exam and entry level employment as a Paramedic in the State of Arkansas. Students enrolling in the program must have ACT or equivalent scores of reading 19, writing 19, Math 16, or complete the appropriate remedial courses and have a current Arkansas EMT license. Courses include off-campus clinical and internship rotations. Students must maintain a C average in all courses to progress through and graduate from the program. Students will be eligible to challenge the NREMT Licensure Exam after completion of the program. Graduation does not guarantee licensure or employment as a paramedic.
