No Certificate of Proficiency degree is eligible for Federal Financial Aid. Federal Financial Aid pays for courses of students pursuing Technical Certificate and/or higher degree.

Completing the CP/TC Teacher Assistant prepares students for the ParaPro Assessment. This is a general aptitude test required for paraprofessional certification. Testing scores are required for paraprofessional application at each school district within Arkansas.

This assessment measures foundational knowledge in the areas of Math, Writing, and Reading. The Praxis Study Companion for the ParaPro Assessment can be found here: <u>https://www.ets.org/s/parapro/pdf/1755.pdf</u>

Students interested in completing the ParaPro test should contact Callie Fore at the Southwest Arkansas Education Cooperative (SWAEC): 870-777-3076 ext 138; <u>callie.fore@swaec.org.</u> There is a \$75 test registration fee. Testing will need to be scheduled a week in advance. Test completion time is recommended for 2 ½ hours.
