The middle school and secondary education tracks allow candidates to focus on specific content areas of most significant interest.

Completing the CP/TC Teacher Assistant prepares students for the ParaPro Assessment. This is a general aptitude test required for paraprofessional certification. Testing scores are required for paraprofessional application at each school district within Arkansas.

This assessment measures foundational knowledge in the areas of Math, Writing, and Reading. The Praxis Study Companion for the ParaPro Assessment can be found here: <u>https://www.ets.org/s/parapro/pdf/1755.pdf</u>

Testing will need to be scheduled a week in advance. Test completion time is recommended for 2 ½ hours.
